



Percy Finch/Widmer-Bradfield Selection Policy

Events

Percy Finch is played between HRTC and RMTC by amateur players.

Percy Finch (1) is played as a 6 singles/3 doubles format. Each match is best of 3 sets.

Percy Finch (2) is played as a singles and doubles event similar to Percy Finch (1) but is based upon the size of the travelling team. Each match is best of 3 sets.

Widmer-Bradfield is played between HRTC and BTC by amateur players.

Widmer-Bradfield is played as a 4 singles/2 doubles format. Each match is best of 5 sets, unless agreed to prior to the tournament.

Entry

Entry will be sent out to all HRTC members with relevant handicaps.

Percy Finch (1) and Widmer-Bradfield teams are selected with the primary function of having the most competitive team available.

Percy-Finch (2) will be selected to provide opportunities for the next level players to play competitive tennis.

Entry nominations close at least 6 weeks before event, playoffs concluded and team finalized by at least 4 weeks from event.

Selection Criteria

1. Draw up a list of entries based upon handicap order, both singles and doubles.
2. Take the top 6 from each list for the Percy (1) team, top 4 for Widmer-Bradfield.
3. Any player with 1 handicap of the cut-off may challenge for a place in the team. Playoff will be best of 3 sets, played between nomination and team selection.
4. Players making Percy Finch (1) in one format but not the other may play Percy Finch (2) in the reverse format, should they desire to do so.
5. Due to varying size of Percy Finch (2), selection will be done for the appropriate number of players as per above method.
